Every year since 2005, we invite local nonprofits to apply to our annual Community Grants Cycle (CGC) to support programs that strengthen our

community. The applications listed on <a href="www.BainbridgeGives.org">www.BainbridgeGives.org</a> (the CGC's online grant catalog) have been vetted and are recommended for funding by 46 volunteers from our community. This year we received 56 applications from all sectors, and the BCF grants evaluation team approved 52 of those applications for a total of \$430,098 in requests.

BCF receives more requests from the Community Grants Cycle than we can fund on our own. Now through June 13th, <a href="www.BainbridgeGives.org">www.BainbridgeGives.org</a> is live! 

## Vaccine Rates on Bainbridge Island

## Percent of 12 + Kitsap Residents who have Initiated Vaccination by Geographic Region and Week of Vaccination



According to weekly updates from Kitsap Public Health District, Bainbridge Island is the highest vaccinated region in Kitsap County. The data on the Vaccine Distribution Demographics page, found on their website here, reveals how local vaccination rates vary by age, race, ethnicity, language and geographic area. Kitsap Public Health is collaborating with service organizations and healthcare providers to support equitable access to vaccines for eligible county residents.
