The annual Community Grants Cycle (CGC) is a community-based approach to grantmaking which ensures that local needs are met by our own informed and engaged community members. Each year, up to 60 nonprofits request grants of \$1,000 to \$10,000 through the CGC for programs such as nutritious meals for those in need, expanding work opportunities for vulnerable populations, or installing and maintaining Island hiking trails.
