HOW THE COMMUNITY GRANT CYCLE WORKS:

The Bainbridge Community Foundation invites nonprofits and programs serving the Bainbridge community to apply for funding through our annual Community Grants Cycle (CGC) to support the projects which will allow them to achieve their mission. The organizations listed here have submitted proposals for our annual CGC. Our 46 person CGC Evaluation Team has reviewed each application, performed a virtual site visit for most, and completed an evaluation of each application. Each organization was also screened for financial health and current nonprofit status. The applications listed here have been vetted and are recommended for funding. This year we received 61 applications from organizations of all sectors for a total of \$453,398 in requests.
